Lynn Donnelly: School Improvement Team Update:

**Fall Progress report was submitted. Defining SIT : this organization is required by the state to monitor school improvement and progress with specified goals.
Jennifer Patton (counselor's office) – Discussion of pre and post tests for freshman.
Of the senior class 42% have processed their applications to colleges with 355 applications to over 300 colleges.
Naviance Program : Discussion of summer school to accommodate those students who had failing grades during the school year.**

BUDS REPORT:

**Spoke of 3A Construction with introduction of Dave Jorschumb (Project Manger and associated with the BVSD Bond Program).
The renovation of Boulder High began 4 years ago with the focus on physical deficiencies, educational specifics were evaluated, and sports facilities were analyzed. The original estimate was \$400,000,000.
Construction will begin April 1.
The exterior renovation will be addressed during school hours.
Interior renovation will occur during breaks and summer break.**

The school will lose 19 parking spaces. If there are add'l funds remaining at the completion of the project additional parking will be added in the grass field east of the softball field.

The School Budget is \$11,812,819.

Construction Budget is \$8,969,923.

Current Design Development \$9,385,882, 30% of the current school budget.

The 30% is to address soft costs, unanticipated expenses, and example asbestos.

The new gym will model the Monarch gym.

Energy efficiency and the new renovation are being addressed as best can.
